Robert E. Smart, 90 died November 5, 2008 at National Park Medical Center. He was a resident of Hot Springs Village for 27 years. (moved here in Dec. 1981)

He was born in Ironton, Ohio on November 8, 1917, the son of Arthur and Virgie Smart. He attended Virginia Polytechnical College and was graduated from American Electronics Institute with a degree in Electronic Engineering. He was a retired Vice President of Administration and Finance for the Memcor Division of E-Systems, Inc. in Huntington, Indiana.

He was a member of the Kirk-In-The Pines Presbyterian Church, Past President of the HSV-Men's Golf Association, Past Treasurer & Tournament Director of the Garland County Seniors Golf Association and a charter member of the HSV Rotary Club and served that organization for six years as Secretary and Treasurer. He was very active in civic affairs in Huntington, Indiana serving as Past President of the Chamber of Commerce, Rotary Club, Public Library Board of Directors, United Fund, LaFontaine Country Club and Wabash Valley Golf Association. He also served as a member of the Huntington Economic Development Commission, the Huntington Quasquecentennial Committee, the

Indiana Governor's Council on CETA and the Indiana Manufacturer's Association.

He is survived by his wife, Mildred, of Hot Springs Village, one son, William, of Bangkok, Thailand, one sister, Virginia Bryant, of Ironton, Ohio,, three grandchildren Kelly Hollingsworth, Nashville,TN,Shannon Koeller,Santa Rosa,CA.,Erin Padavana, Castro Valley,CA.
