



Robert Strouts

June 25, 1918 - February 21, 2011

Lt. Commander (retired) Robert A. Strouts, 92, of Hot Springs Village, passed away on Monday, February 21, 2011. Robert was born June 25, 1918 in Minneapolis, Minnesota to the late William and Margaret Strouts. The family moved to Sparta, Wisconsin where he grew up and graduated from Sparta High School in 1936. He attended the University of Wisconsin at La Crosse.

Robert enlisted in the United States Navy in 1940 to serve his country during World War II. He retired after 30 years of active duty, serving aboard the USS Juneau and the USS Valley Forge. During this time he also served at various stations in Germany, Paris and Cuba, eventually settling in Annandale, VA with his wife and children. After retirement from active duty, he worked for the Navy Federal Credit Union until 1979 when he retired and moved to Hot Springs Village, Arkansas.

He is survived by his devoted and loving wife of 69 years, Arlene Day Strouts, one sister, Janet Hendrickson of Little Rock, AR; one son, Robert A. Strouts and wife Linda of Herndon, VA; one daughter, Kris Strouts of Little Rock, AR; 3 grandchildren, Matthew Strouts of Fayetteville, AR; Michael Strouts of Silver Spring, MD; Jennifer Strouts of Reston, VA.
